As I have recently reported, Hydro One has a brand new board of directors appointed by Wynne and a spanking new CEO at seven times the pay of the old one. This fall they have hired a number of very high priced EVPs (you don't want to know the pay for these folks) who Wynne and the CEO, Mayo Schmidt, say are going to turn this ship around.

Here is the comment on Hydro disconnections from one these recently hired EVP's (who admittedly is still trying to find the light switch):

?Our hearts go out to these folks. I continue to recommend folks in North Hastings who are having trouble with Hydro One contact the Ombudsman Fiona Crean for assistance. She at least met with us this summer and has nine months on the job now. She gets it.
