

Sloan running to represent Hastings-Lennox and Addington

Derek Sloan has announced his candidacy as Member of Provincial Parliament for the riding of Hastings-Lennox and Addington. The announcement came on Friday, March 25. Sloan was a representative of the riding from 2019 to 2021 as a member of the Conservative Party. He now returns to the race as the Leader of the Ontario Party, a position he took in December.
