The Training and Learning Centre is a non-profit organization funded by the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development, and was founded in 1993. They help adults upgrade their skills or learn a new skill for employment, apprenticeships, secondary or post-secondary education, and furthering their independence.
